Plastics and waste recycling

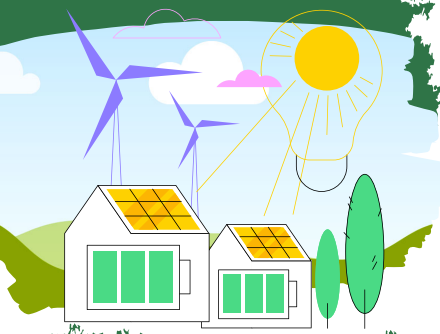
Transport-
